Passport

- The best is to have a US Passport valid until March 2010
- Or New York new "enhanced" driver's license (\$30 more than regular license).
- As of 10/1/08, the government is not requiring a passport when traveling on a cruise ship to/from the Caribbean. IF a medical emergency occurs and requires a flight back from the Caribbean, you must have a passport.

The all-inclusive price of the ten-day cruise includes:

(PER PERSON- \$1,375 - inside; \$1,540 - outside; \$1,845 - balcony).

Cancellation Penalties: Insurance premium is non-refundable. All other money will be refunded for any cancellation on or before November 10, 2009. In the event that you must cancel for reasons other than sickness or death in the family (covered by the insurance) on or after November 11, 2009, all money is non-refundable.

- Fly into Newark, New Jersey Airport on day before — January 13th (Wed). Call Bonnie Lee at Jetaway (1-800-724-1386) if you need help to book a flight.
- Stay at Newark Days Inn Airport - \$100 per room; call 973-242-0900 to make your own reservation. Free shuttle from airport.
- Take taxi (round trip shuttle) to Cape Liberty Cruise Port, Bayonne, NJ, (10 miles; around 15-20 minutes). The approximate cost of \$50-\$75 will be reimbursed.
