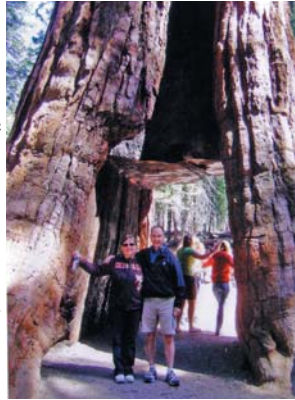

The Schedule

(Times are tentative)

Day 1 - September 14
(Tuesday)

4:00 AM - Leave from Endicott (Shafer's Bus) for Newark Airport
6:45 AM - Arrive in Newark, New Jersey
8:40 AM - Depart on Continental Airlines (non-stop)
12:00 PM - Arrive in San Francisco. Travel east

toward Yosemite Park. Lodge in Merced - LD

Day 2 - September 15 (Wednesday)

Tour Yosemite National Park and see all of its grandeur. Lunch on your own in the Park. Lodge in Oakhurst - BD

Note: A typical day would be breakfast in hotel (6:45 AM); devotions on bus (8:00 AM), touring all day; lunch around 1:00 PM; dinner at hotel or restaurant around 6:00 PM. Free time in the evenings.

Day 3 - September 16 (Thursday)

Return to Yosemite National Park to visit Mariposa Grove (big trees) via a tram ride; ride on the Sugar Pine Railroad. Travel to Paso Robles and lodge there for the night. - BLD

Day 4 - September 17 (Friday)

Tour Hearst Castle in San Simeon; in the afternoon travel up Route 1 (The Big Sur Highway) along the Pacific coastline. Lodge in Monterey - BLD

Day 5 - September 18 (Saturday)

Drive the 17 mile route along Monterey Peninsula; lunch in Carmel; visit the Monterey Aquarium; travel to the San Francisco Bay area and lodge there for two nights - BLD

Day 6 - September 19 (Sunday)

Sunday service at Fremont; tour San Francisco; cruise the Bay; tour Alcatraz, Fisherman's Wharf and the Golden Gate Bridge - BLD

Day 7 - September 20 - (Monday)

6:30 AM - Leave hotel for airport
7:00 AM - Arrive at San Francisco Airport
8:50 AM - Depart on Continental Airlines (non-stop)
5:20 PM - Arrive in Newark - motor coach to Endicott (stop for dinner on your own)
9:45 PM - Estimated arrival time back in Endicott - B

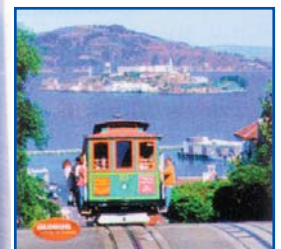


Note: The times and days of the above itinerary are subject to change, however each event will be included in the tour. Each day will be a full schedule of travel, sightseeing and meals.
